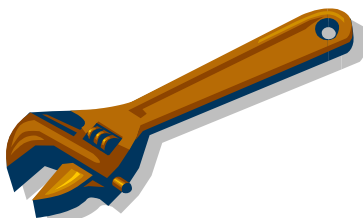

# BARGAINING UPDATE

## We Fail to find Agreement in Conciliation

Your negotiation committee met with the company with the assistance of Federal Conciliation Officer Patt Dunn on April 2nd, 3rd and 4th in Saskatoon.

Although several items were agreed to and despite the extensive discussion we were unable to reach agreement on some crucial issues.

This is not a comprehensive list but the main issues outstanding are;

- **Jurisdiction**—The company will not agree any and language which would protect the work done day to day by our members.
- **Wages**—The company and the union are still some distance apart on this issue despite the union's very reasonable proposal.
- **Pension**—Your committee has tried since the beginning of negotiations to improve the pension plan. The company continues to be steadfast in their refusal to come to agreement on this issue.
- **Scheduling**—The union has been trying to get language into the agreement which would stop the favoritism the company has shown in scheduling in some locations.



The union will be holding meetings across Western Canada to bring you up to date, give you a voice and to ask for a rejection of the company last offer. We will also be asking you to approve strike action to back our demands.
